



Life Lessons Across Cultures and Around the World

Each year, the Lions International Youth Camp and Exchange Program introduces young people to life in other cultures by helping them travel abroad.

Lions Youth Camps last one or two weeks and bring young people (ages 16 -22) from around the world together. Youths from at least ten different nations meet in a camp. Camps usually include a family stay that lasts between one and four weeks. More than 100 Lions camps in about 39 countries are held each year.

About 170 young people from Germany go abroad – about 200 international guests visit Germany.

Activities include visits to places of cultural or natural interest, sporting events and country presentations by the camp participants.

About Lions Foundation Germany:

The Lions Youth Exchange in Germany is operated by the respective districts and the Lions Foundation Germany Hilfswerk der Deutschen Lions (HDL). Young people (Lions or not) up to the age of 23 can explore numerous opportunities for further personal education and development.

Additional to the Lions International Youth Camps the German Lions Foundation coordinates and accompanies the organisation of the International Lions Youth Forum - an ambitious summer academy for high-school graduates, students and trainees from all over Europe.

Furthermore the HDL supervises national and international development aid projects and emergency relief programs of the German Lions as well as the life-skills program Lions-Quest.
