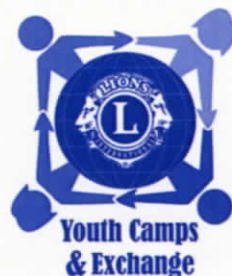

CAMP LOCATION:

The Camp 2016 will take place in the north east part of Iceland near **Akureyri**, which is the biggest town outside the Capital area. In the area are also other towns, **Dalvík**, **Fjallabyggd** and **Husavík** named from west to east, small fishing villages and farmland – and Iceland's beautiful nature.

Within one to two hours distance from Akureyri are many beautiful and interesting places such as a **Lake Myvatn** area with its rich bird life and evidences of volcanic activity, **Dimmuborgir lava formations** and **Geothermal Spa and Nature Baths**.

Whale watching tours and Whale museum in Husavík town.

The tumbling waterfall, **Godafoss** (Waterfall of the Gods) and the **Dettifoss** waterfall with the greatest volume of any waterfall in Europe, 500 cubic metres of water per second plunges over the edge.

The area also offers numerous options for outdoor activities such as: **long and short hiking trails**, **swimming pools** (at least one in every town heated by geothermal water), **sea angling and horse riding** to name a few. **Culture and art** also provide many exciting possibilities with various **museums, exhibitions and galleries**.
