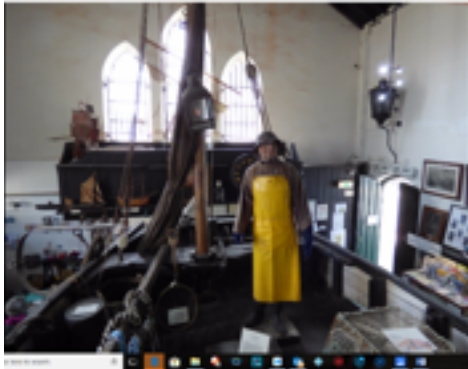


# MD105 Youth Camp



## Hastings

Hastings is really three towns in one joined by a level promenade; the Old Town to the east, the bustling contemporary shopping Town Centre in the middle and St Leonards to the west featuring the classical elegance of James Burton's architecture and the fashionable Norman Road – recently named as the new 'Portobello Road-on sea' by The Times` and offering a great collection of antique shops and vintage galleries.



The Hastings Fishermen's Museum is one of the town's most popular tourist attractions. It is inside a church built on the Stade in 1852, which fell out of use after the Second World War. In 1956 local people took over the old Fishermen's Church. They pulled inside one of the last of the luggers (sailing fishing boats), the Enterprise, which only just fits. There are many models, photos, paintings, nets and a wide variety of other fishing artefacts.

## London

No trip to Southern England would be complete without a trip to London. We will take you to Buckingham Palace to watch the 'Changing of The Guard' and you will be free for the rest of the day to explore our capital city sights.
