### Doncaster

Doncaster is in the county of South Yorkshire – Population about 109,805 – a Metropolitan borough, South Yorkshire Region. It is a large market town with its surrounding suburbs and settlements, the town forms part of the Metropolitan Borough of Doncaster. Doncaster is about 17 miles (30 km) north-east of Sheffield, with which it is served by an international airport, Doncaster Sheffield Airport in Finningley.



**York** is the traditional county town in the county of Yorkshire. York Minster and a variety of cultural and sporting activities make it a popular tourist destination.

The city was founded by the Romans in 71 AD. In the Middle Ages, York grew as a major wool trading centre and became the capital of the northern ecclesiastical province of the Church of England, a role it has retained.
